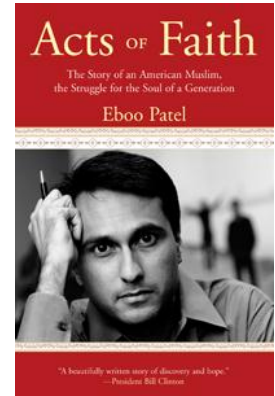

One of the speakers at The Interfaith Thanksgiving Service in November will be **Josh Stanton**. A native of Bethesda, Maryland, Joshua Stanton is a Founding Editor-in-Chief of the [Journal of Inter-Religious Dialogue™](#) and a Schusterman Rabbinical Fellow at [Hebrew Union College](#). He is also a founding co-Director of Lessons of a Lifetime™, a nursing home-based project designed to improve intergenerational relations. A graduate of Amherst College, he is the recipient of numerous leadership awards. He is an Interfaith Youth Core alumnus, blogger for the *Huffington Post* and a writer, whose articles and papers have been published in over nine languages. In addition to his other work and study, Stanton serves on the Board of Directors of World Faith, as well as the Education as Transformation project. Josh co-founded [Religious Freedom USA](#), a New York City based initiative that seeks to defend the core American value of religious freedom.

Another speaker will be **Frank Fredericks**. A born-again Christian from Oregon, Frank Fredericks is the Executive Director of [World Faith](#), an interfaith community service network with chapters in six countries. An alumnus of New York University, he previously worked in the music industry, managing artists such as Lady Gaga, and founding Çöñâr Records. Fredericks works as an Online Marketing Consultant and has consulted businesses, artists, and non-profits, including the Cordoba Initiative. As an active blogger, Frank contributes to a number of blogs, including the *Huffington Post*. He is an Interfaith Youth Core alumnus, UN Alliance of Civilizations presenter, and has been interviewed by Good Morning America, NPR, *New York Magazine*, and various international media outlets.
